
TRASH DAY

Time and Place

Please have your trash out by 7 A.M. at the curb or alleyway, outside of fences or gates. For alley service, please mark your street address in the alley or on your containers for identification by our drivers.

Additional charges apply for pick up of oversize or bulk items, such as furniture. Please call customer service for more information regarding any additional charges, or to schedule pick up of a bulk item.

Container Size

To reduce chances of injury to our drivers, for non-WM containers please use containers no larger than 32 gallons weighing no more than 40 pounds when full.

Please bag all household trash, bagging and securely tying bags will eliminate blowing trash and help reduce odors. Do not use 55 gallon drums, paper sacks or boxes as trash containers.

OTHER WASTE

Yard Waste

Cut branches into four foot lengths or less and tie them in bundles no more than 12 inches in diameter.

Please limit to four bundles per week.

Leaves and grass clippings should be bagged, tied securely and placed with other items for outside collection.

Please limit to ten bags per week.

Holiday Service

We observe six holidays each year:

NEW YEAR'S DAY
MEMORIAL DAY
INDEPENDENCE DAY
LABOR DAY
THANKSGIVING DAY
CHRISTMAS DAY

Holidays may affect regular collection schedules. If your trash day falls on or after a Waste Management (WM) observed holiday, trash collection will generally be delayed by one day for the remainder of the holiday week.

For example, if the 4th of July falls on Tuesday, customers who usually have Tuesday service will shift to Wednesday. However, Monday customers will still receive their service on Monday.

Problems

Please report any problems or service issues within 24 hours of your pickup day.

Cardboard Boxes

Flatten cardboard boxes prior to placing at the curb for disposal.

Do not use cardboard boxes as trash containers.

Non-collectible Items

We can not accept soil, sod, loose yard debris, rocks, uncut or untied branches, bricks, concrete, building materials, auto parts and liquid waste with regular service.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS AND SPECIAL EVENTS

Make sure there are no bicycles, toys or yard items at the curb on pickup day. We are not responsible for the loss or damage of personal items.

Customers are responsible for the maintenance and safe use of Waste Management trash containers.

We strongly recommend that you periodically disinfect your container by rinsing it with 1 ounce household bleach in 1 gallon of water.

IN COLORADO RESIDENTS CANNOT DISPOSE OF TIRES, BATTERIES, OR USED OIL IN RESIDENTIAL TRASH.

Special Services

Please contact us for pricing and scheduling pickup of large or bulk items at least 24 hours in advance of your collection day.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

Hazardous Waste

We are unable to collect commercial or industrial waste, fire extinguishers, propane tanks or hazardous chemical waste of any kind (flammables, explosives, or other chemicals) as part of your residential collection service. Some examples of household hazardous waste include paint and stain, photographic chemicals, ammunition and insecticides.

For collection of residential hazardous waste call your county health department or municipal office; many counties and cities have made special arrangements for the collection of hazardous materials.

Hypodermic needles must be disposed of in specialized "sharps" containers. Needles, which are not disposed of properly, pose a medical hazard for our drivers, other waste handlers, and potentially your own neighbors. You can contact your medical professional for proper disposal or our offices to participate in our Sharps Disposal by Mail System.
