



Castle Pines Emergency Services Suggestions for While You Are Away

- Give your house that “lived in” look while you’re away.
- Use a timer on indoor lights. Look for a timer that can be set to a random pattern so the lights don’t turn on and off at exactly the same times every day.
- Be sure to have someone mow the lawn or shovel the drive and walk if you’ll be gone more than a few days.
- Stop all deliveries and either suspend or have a neighbor collect your mail and/or newspapers, no matter how long or short you will be away.
- Don’t announce your absence on answering machine messages.
- Have a neighbor, or friend, check the inside of your home to prevent a small leak from becoming a small disaster.
- Fill out a [Vacation Check Request](#) form and return it to Emergency Services.
- Make sure Castle Pines Emergency Services has your proper alarm code, and then set your alarm system.
- Make sure your Knox Box key is current.
